How to Use PhoneMail

How to Access to the MailBox Main Menu

Remote retrieve message at any tone phone please dial 2460 2460 (Eng.) or 2468 2468 (Chi) with the same procedure as above.

How to Create Greeting

1.	Access to the MailBox Main Menu first, then
2.	Press [9] to change function
3.	Press [1] to record own greeting or Press [2] to add name to the standard greeting, then [#]
4.	Listen to the greeting playback and then:
	Press [2] to confirm and save
	Press [3] to cancel
5.	Press [2] to save or press [1] to record a new greeting again



How to Retrieve a Message

- 2. Press [1] to listen message
- 3. After/while listening can press [2] to save or Press [3] to delete

Useful Tips to control a message when listening:

- 1. To pause, Press [8] or release pause, Press [8] again
- To rewind message by 8 seconds while playback, Press [7]
- To rewind message to the beginning, Press [7][7]
- 4. To rewind to the beginning of the previous message while playback, Press [7][7][7]
- 5. To fast forward message by 8 seconds while playback, Press [9]
- 6. To fast forward message to the end of current message while playback, Press [9][9]
- 7. To adjust volume, press a range from lowest [41] to highest [49]
- 8. To adjust speed, press a range from slowest [61] to fastest [69]

How to Use Your Password

- 1. Access to the MailBox Main Menu first, then
- 2. Press [9] to change function
- 3. Press [3] to create/change password
- 4. Enter new password (1-6 digits) and Press [#] or Press [#] only to cancel the existing password
- A voice prompt will confirm your instructions to ensure you have entered your password correctly.
- Press [1] to skip password for next mailbox access with *90
 Press [2] to set password need for next mailbox access with *90

How to Send a Message

- 2. Press [2] to send a message to other PCCW mailbox directly
- 3. Enter the destination and follow by the [#]
- 4. Record your message after a beep and press [#] when completed
- 5. Press [2] to send , or press [1] to rewind your recording message

If

Press [1], it will rewind your recording message and prompt:

Press [1] to continue your recording message from here

Press [2] to send

Press [*] to cancel

Press [#] to to end your rewinding message

How to Reply a Message

1	Access	to the	Mailbox	Main	Menu	first	then

- 2. Press [1] to listen
- 3. Press [4] to reply
- 4. Record your message after a beep and press [#] when completed
- 5. Press [2] to send to the caller's mailbox, or press [1] to rewind your recording message



How to Transfer / Broadcast a Message

1.	Access to the Mailbox Main Menu first, then
2.	Press [1] to listen
3.	Press [5] to transfer
4.	Enter the destination follow by the [#]
5	Press [2] to send, or press [1] to add your recording comment

How to Create Mailing List

1.	Access to the Mailbox Main Menu first, then
2.	Press [9] to Modify other function
3.	Press [4] to Administrate mailing list
4.	Press [2] to Create
5.	Prompt new mailing list number, then enter a destination & follow by [#], the final destination
	follow by [#] [#].

How to Modify Mail List

1	Access to the Mailbox Main Menu first, then

۷.	Press [9] to Modify other function
3.	Press [4] to Administrate mailing list
4.	Press [1] to Modify
5.	Enter the number of list to modify, follow by [#]
6.	Read out the 1st setting destination number and then:
	Press [1] to listen to the next destination
	Press [2] to add a new destination from here
	Press [3] to delete
	Press [#] to complete modify work
	Press [*] to cancel

How to Exit MailBox

Press [*] to return to previous menu	
Press [*] [*] to go to main menu	
Press [*] [*] [*] to exit the mailbox main menu	



PhoneMail Quick Reference Guide

To Turn Message Taking Options On/Off

Turn On	Turn Off	Message Taking Option
Press [*] [9] [1]	Press [#] [9] [1]	all calls
Press [*] [9] [2]	Press [#] [9] [2]	while the line is busy
Press [*] [9] [3]	Press [#] [9] [3]	for unanswered calls
Press Flash then [*] [9] [5]		On-line transfer caller to PhoneMail

Useful Tips

To control a message when listening	Press [4] [1] to [4] [9] to adjust volume
Press [7] to rewind 8 seconds	[1] being the lowest volume
Press [7] [7] to rewind to beginning	[2] being the highest volume
Press [7] [7] [7] to rewind to the beginning of previous	
message	
Press [8] to pause (To resume, press [8] again)	Press [6] [1] to [6] [9] to adjust speed
Press [9] to forward 8 seconds	[1] being the slowest speed
Press [9] [9] to forward to end	[9] being the fastest speed
Press [*] to return to previous menu, and [*] [*] to go to main menu	

^{**} Number Recall is unable to record phone numbers of incoming calls made in certain situations

Examples include calls made from payphones or if the caller chooses not to transmit his or her phone no.
